Hey Gators!

We hope you all enjoyed your 4th of July holiday. If you are not going to be at practice on Wednesday, July 5 (after the long weekend), please be sure to let your coach know what you want to swim for the July 8th meet prior to this coming weekend.

Also, please be sure to inform coaches when you are not going to be at a swim meet, or when you will only be at meets for a portion of the time. We have had a lot of problems this season with people not showing up when they aren't signed out, or leaving early and skipping out on events and relays that have to then be rearranged. We understand that everyone has busy summers, but we NEED to have it IN WRITTING when swimmers are going to be out. Coaches need to be informed of such schedules before Wednesday morning prior to the meet you will be gone. This helps meets to run more smoothly, and it also helps avoid canceling relays and leaving three swimmers out of relays when one person isn't there! Thanks for your help on this!

Also, please remember that speaking to your age group coaches while they are on deck is a bit difficult, and we would be better able to serve you if you contact us outside of practice times. This includes parents talking to their own swimmers while they are in the water. Except for getting your swimmers out of practice early for other engagements, parents shouldn't be on deck and interrupting swim sets to "coach" their own swimmers.
